






2. You are:




31,4% of participants are teacher and 68,6% participants are students






The choice to participate in the **Erasmus+** *"DIGITALLY READY GENERATION* **FOR THE LABOUR MARKET** " has been determined by:









4. The practical arrangements (hotel, meals) were good

14,3% participants diagree; 31,4% of participants neither agree nor disagree and 54,3% participants agree that there was active participation of all the partners









6. The level of English was good









8. The visits and outdoor activities led to cooperation between students and a better understanding of the Romanian culture


